**Good evening everyone and welcome to The Elmbridge Xcel Sports Hub for this Cherry Red Records Premier Challenge Cup, 3rd Round tie with first time opponents Hilltop FC.**

We extend a particularly warm welcome to all their players, officials and supporters, and of course to tonight's three match officials.

Our visitors, who ground-share at Hillingdon Borough FC, are playing their first season in the Combined Counties League and are members of Division One.

This follows their promotion from the Premier Division of the Middlesex County League, based on points per game gained prior to Covid-19.

They are having a fine first season and currently top the table, having lost only three games, so will provide strong opposition this evening.

Our first two seasons in the Premier Challenge Cup saw us have good runs, reaching the 4th Round in 2016-17 and the Semi-Final in 2017-18.

We then made immediate exits in the following two seasons, before having a good win over Southall in 2020-21 in a competition that was unfortunately terminated early due to Covid-19.

Should the scores still be level after 90 minutes this evening, the result will be decided by kicks from the penalty-spot.

Last Saturday our promotion hopes took a big hit as we went down 1-0 here to big, strong, and physical opponents, Beckenham Town, who leapfrogged us into top spot in the table with the benefit of two games in hand.

This was our first league defeat at home this season, and we have now taken just one point out of the last nine, but we know the quality in our squad, and they are determined that this is just a blip and they will turn it around.

There is still a lot of games to be played between now and the end of the season, with top sides meeting each other.

On Saturday, in front of another bumper crowd, we needed to get off to a good start, but it was the visitors

who gained an early upper-hand with a goal scored after just five minutes, and we then struggled to get a foothold back in the game.

Teams visiting The Hub invariably sit back, allowing us the room in our own half to play our normal game of passing from the back, but from the first whistle Beckenham pressed forward, quickly closing us down.

When we did come more into the game as an attacking force, moves invariably petered out in the final third when faced with the Kent side's uncompromising defence.

Two new signings were brought into our starting line-up

Taurean Roberts is starting his second spell with the club, having a goal per game ratio from the four appearances he made in the 2017-18 season.

Making his debut was the highly rated Ben Krauhaus, who has joined on dual-registration from National League club Bromley to give him more exposure to adult football.

The 18 year-old was certainly left in no doubt as to what to experience as he came up against opponents who stood on little ceremony in breaking up our attacks, and who were happy to concede free-kicks, with the possibility of picking up yellow cards, confident in their defence's ability to see off the threats on their goal.

Beckenham pressed us from the first whistle and took the lead with a fine shot from way outside the box that found the top, left corner.

They then limited us to sporadic attacks, but midway through the first-half we looked to be denied the opportunity to equalise when Harry Mills drove across the box and was clearly pulled down, but the referee waved play-on.

We had a far better opening twenty minutes of the second-half, creating some half chances, but did not have the final ball to pick open an experienced and uncompromising defence.

As the half wore on our best prospect looked to be to capitalise on one of the numerous free-kicks conceded by the visitors, but the quality of delivery was not there when needed.

Apart from the goal, neither of the two goalkeepers had been seriously tested throughout the ninety minutes.

Beckenham ended the match with ten men, two of the seven yellow cards picked up by them being converted to a red, but the three points were taken back to Kent.

Next Saturday we are away to AFC Croydon Athletic, returning here on the following Tuesday, the 15th of February, when Frimley Green are the visitors for a 7.45 pm kick-off.

Both these fixtures are in the Cherry Red Combined Counties League Premier Division South.

In the meantime we hope everyone enjoys this evening's match and has a safe journey home afterwards.

# A Brief History of Hilltop FC

Hilltop Football Club is based in Stonebridge and was founded in 2005. They are currently members of the Combined Counties League Division One and ground-share with Hillingdon Borough at the Middlesex Stadium.

In 2007 the club joined Division Three of the Middlesex County League. At the first attempt the club won promotion to the 2nd Division. After playing in Division Two for two seasons the club left the league.

The club re-joined the Middlesex County League Division Two for the 2014-15 season, and in 2015–16 were relegated to Division Three, having finished bottom.

The club's management was then reformed, and success followed. After finishing second in the league, the club was promoted to Division Two. The club won Division Two the following season, winning promotion to the Middlesex County League Division One.

The 2018-19 season was a turning point for the club. At the first attempt they won the league without losing any games, only conceding 13 goals in the whole season. The club also won the Middlesex County Junior Cup, defeating Western Athletic 6-1 in the Final. They were denied the treble as they lost the Final of the Jim Rodgers Presidents Cup to Clapton CFC.

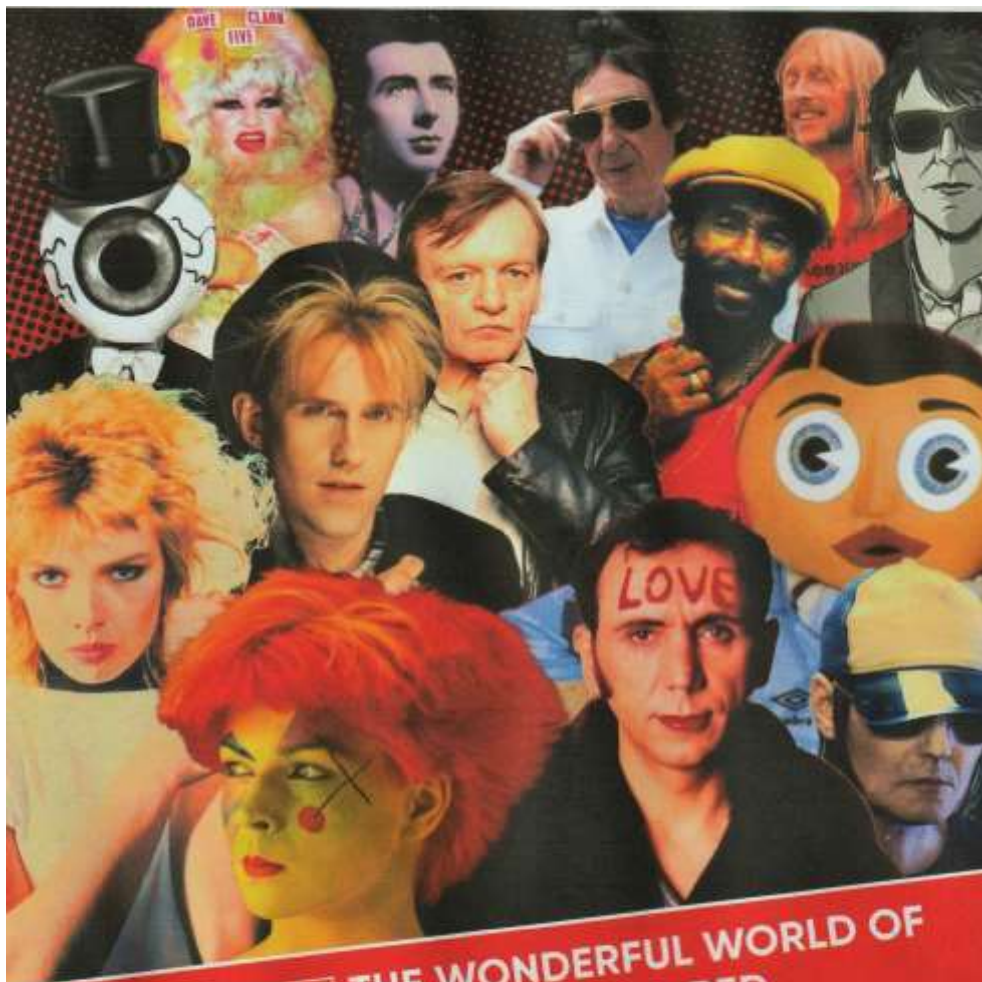
After the reconstruction of the non-league football pyramid the club was promoted to the Combined Counties Football League Division One. This was on the basis of winning the Premier Division of the Middlesex County League in the 2019-20 season on points per game gained prior to Covid 19.

The club has developed over the years, and as from the 2021-22 season have a reserve team, who will be competing in Division One of the Middlesex County League, a women's team competing in the Greater London Women's Football League, and a number of youth teams.

The club draws many of its players from the Somali community in London, and from time to time enter Somali tournaments across the world. The club has travelled to Canada and Somalia to participate in these tournaments. It also participates in the Somali British Champions League and are currently the Champions.

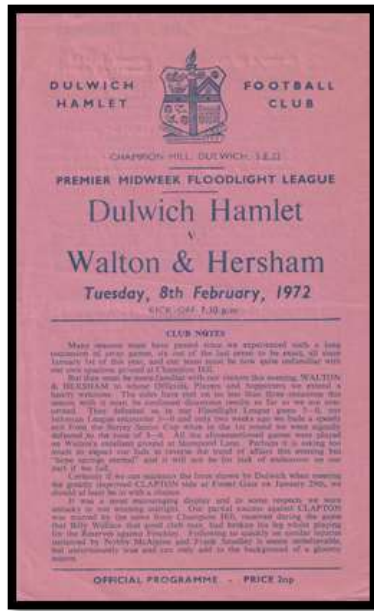

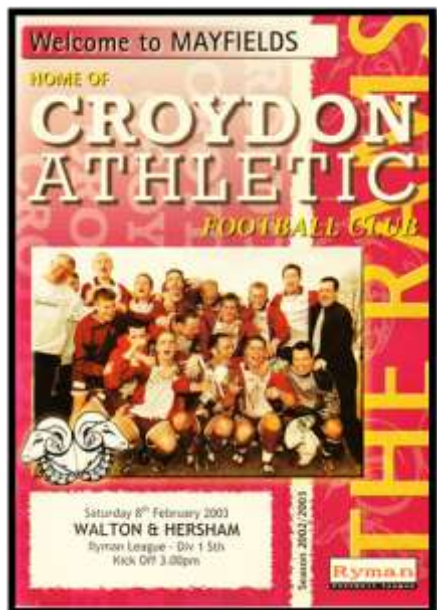

# ***Walton & Hershams F.C. – “The Swans”***

Walton-on-Thames F.C. was formed in 1895, and in 1945, following World War II, amalgamated with Hershams F.C. to form Walton & Hershams F.C., the present club.

The united club immediately joined the newly formed Corinthian League and followed a poor first season with a hat-trick of Championships and a runners-up position.

They also won the Surrey Senior Cup for the first time in 1947-48, beating Isthmian League neighbours Kingstonian 2-1 at Crystal Palace.

Election to the Athenian League soon followed and in their first season, 1950-51, Swans finished runners-up and again won the Surrey Senior Cup at Palace, defeating the much vaunted Dulwich Hamlet 2-1.

## **Great days, big crowds**

These were golden days for the Stompond Lane side and the FA Amateur Cup Semi-Final was reached in successive seasons, 1951-52 and 1952-53, only for Swans to go out to Walthamstow Avenue and Harwich & Parkeston respectively.

During this period the club enjoyed a tremendous following, and a record crowd of 10,000 were at the Lane in 1952 when the famous Crook Town were the visitors for an Amateur Cup tie.

Stars of this era included Swans' most famous player, England and Great Britain Olympic defender C.R. 'Jack' Neale, and the prolific Reg Sentance, still the club's all-time top scorer.

Some lean years followed, although the FA Cup First Round was reached for the first time in 1957-58, Southampton winning 6-1 before 6,000 people at Stompond Lane.

Don Stoker's popular sides of the early 1960's brought cup fever back to the Lane and there were fine runs again in the FA Amateur Cup.

Two late goals by the prolific and popular Brian Jenkins beat the star-studded Wimbledon side in the Surrey Senior Cup Final of 1960-61, and the trophy was retained against Sutton United the following season.

After several years of mid-table respectability, Allen Batsford's appointment as manager in 1967 heralded the start of the most successful period in the club's history.

At the end of his first season, a superb victory over a powerful Wimbledon side in the two legged Final secured the Premier Midweek Floodlit League title, the first of three, followed a year later by the winning of the Athenian League championship for the first time.

The FA Cup First Round Proper was again reached in the following two seasons, only for Swans to lose to Barnet 1-0 in 1969-70 and Telford United 5-2 in 1970-71, both games being played at the Lane.

The runners-up spot in the League was achieved in both those campaigns and the Surrey Senior Cup came back to Stompond Lane in 1970-71, Woking being defeated 3-0 in the Final.

Election to the Isthmian ranks followed, with third place attained in the first season, 1971-72.

## **Wembley at last**

Then followed the most memorable season in the club's history, 1972-73.

The FA Cup First Round barrier was overcome for the first time with Exeter City being defeated 2-1 amid tremendous excitement at the Lane, only for visitors Margate to win by the only goal in the Second Round.

Kingstonian were beaten 2-0 in the Surrey Senior Cup Final and the runners-up spot achieved in the League.

Then on the 14th of April 1973 the ultimate prize was gained at Wembley when 41,000 people saw a last-minute Roger Connell goal against Slough Town bring the FA Amateur Cup to Stompond Lane, the trophy being won without a goal being conceded, a record never to be equaled.

Dave Bassett, Willie Smith and Connell also had the honour of playing for the England Amateur side.

The following season Brian Clough's Brighton & Hove Albion side were held 0-0 at The Lane in the FA Cup First Round, Swans pulling off a sensational result in the replay at The Goldstone Ground, a Clive Foskett hat-trick included in a 4-0 win.

Sadly, when Batsford left for Wimbledon the following season the fine team broke up, the crowds drifted away, and relegation soon followed in 1975.

The FA Cup First Round was surprisingly reached in 1975-76, and a young side put on a battling performance at Selhurst Park against Malcolm Allison's Crystal Palace, only going down 1-0 to a late goal.

Barren years followed, with the club several times being close to extinction.

In the mid 1980's the club was proud to have Sir Stanley Matthews as President, but sides flattered to deceive and only a draw in the final game of the 1986-87 season prevented relegation to Division Two.

### **Promotion**

After 20 years out of the top-flight, a young side under Neil Price at last gained promotion in 1993-94, and the following season the First Round Proper of the FA Cup was again reached, Swansea City winning 2-0 at the Lane.

However Swans' Centenary celebrations were spoilt by relegation after only two seasons back in the Premier, but under the management of Laurie Craker the team ensured the stay in Division One was as brief as possible, promotion being gained on the last day of the campaign.

After a creditable first season back in the Premier Division it again proved to be a struggle to remain there, and at the end of the 1999-2000 season Swans finished in bottom spot and relegation again became a reality.

Swans had to wait until the 2004-05 season before more success came to Stompond Lane after long-serving player Alan Dowson took over as manager in October.

After defeat in his first match in charge, Dowson led the team to a record breaking 13 match winning sequence, fine runs in the FA Trophy and League Cup, and promotion as runners-up in the Ryman League Division One.

The Surrey Senior Cup Final was reached for the first time in 31 years, the Swans only losing a thrilling game against AFC Wimbledon 2-1 after extra-time before close to 4,000 people at Woking.

After a creditable first season back in the Premier Division a poor start to 2006-07 led to Dowson's early resignation and eventual relegation yet again.

Since then Swans remained in Division One, facing relegation fights on several occasions, until 2015-16, when a third from bottom finish finally saw them go down ending a 45 year unbroken stay in the Isthmian League.

At the end of September 2017 Swans were forced to leave their home of 8 decades, Stompond Lane, when it was sold for development, the club moving to a new home at a purpose-built Sports Hub in Waterside Drive.

After two good seasons in the Combined Counties League Premier Division, a poor 2018-19 led to a bottom place finish and relegation to Division One.

Then, following two seasons that remained unfinished due to the Covid-19 virus, Swans' record of finishing in third and second places gained them promotion under a PPG (points per game) system, and they will now play this season in the new Combined Counties League Premier Division South.
